The Freehold Memorial Day Parade Committee, in conjunction with local veterans organizations, is now accepting applications for participation in the 146th Freehold Memorial Day Parade to be held on Monday, May 25, 2020. This is one of the oldest and largest such parades in New Jersey to honor our military veterans.

Registration for the parade will begin at 7:30 a.m. at the corner of Brinkerhoff Avenue and Main Street in Freehold. All units **must** register by 9:15 a.m. as the parade steps off Brinkerhoff Avenue promptly at 10:00 a.m.

Please take note of the parade rules enclosed. Upon return of the completed and signed application, all units are entered into the judging competition for their category. **Any unit not adhering to the aforementioned rules will be disqualified from the judging.**

Enclosed is a registration form. Please complete all sections with special attention to your announcement and return it **no later than May 1, 2020**. All units will be brought up for approval by the Freehold Memorial Day Parade Committee. Note - the Freehold Memorial Day Parade committee reserves the right to decline any group's participation.

Rules and Guidelines

1. Please include your announcement for the Master of Ceremonies with your registration. (Please Note: We reserve the right to shorten any announcement as necessary. Additionally, if you do not include an announcement, the MC will announce your organization's name ONLY.)
2. Upon receipt of your application, the Freehold Memorial Day Parade Committee will review it and vote on your acceptance. At approval of your group's participation, you will receive an email confirming your acceptance. (Please Note: The Freehold Memorial Day Parade Committee will not deny any application based on race, gender, age, political view, sexual orientation, gender identity, nationality, or any other category protected by law.)
3. All units must complete the entire parade route ending IN the Monmouth County Courthouse parking lot, NOT on the street.
4. No unit is allowed to cause an undue delay in the parade. The parade will not be permitted to stop for any reason - this includes drilling and/or performing in front of the Reviewing Stand.
5. All units MUST return a registration form in order to march in the parade.
6. You will be assigned a line of march which is unchangeable. If you have any questions or concerns please address them with the parade official nearest you.
7. ALL vehicles that will be in the parade (or dropping anything off to marching units) MUST be in their place no later than 8:00 am. At 8:00 the roads around the parade route, including where the units line up, will CLOSE and no vehicle will be allowed into the area beyond that point. NO EXCEPTIONS! (Marchers can come later, but cars, floats, horse trailers, etc. must be in place BEFORE 8:00 as per local and county law enforcement.)
